Overview | Retail Leasing

- While headwinds have gathered strength for the U.S. consumer, little weakness is apparent in Boston's retail market, which remains one of the tightest of the major markets nationally.
- The availability rate of 3.2% reflects both standout demand and a lack of speculative development.
- With just 200,000 SF of space underway remaining available, and a long list of tenants vying for it, fundamentals are expected to remain solid even as a recession looms.

- Elevated interest rates appear to have finally depressed capital markets, and expectations are growing for 2023 to be one of the lightest investment years in a decade.
